Suspect identified in deadly bar shooting

STATESVILLE- The Iredell County Sheriff's Office has identified a man wanted for fatally shooting one man and wounding another at a Statesville bar on May 29.

According to a release from the Sheriff's Office, deputies were called to **the Tienda "Los Jarochas"** located at 114 Third Creek Road around 1 a.m. Sunday morning. When deputies arrived, they found Victor Raul Torres Mondragon, of Yadkinville, unresponsive at the bar.

Mondragon had received a gunshot wound and was pronounced dead at the scene, the sheriff's office said. Deputies said a second man was shot twice in the lower leg. He was taken to the hospital where he was treated and released.

Witnesses said two people were involved in the shooting and left in an SUV identified as a white Lincoln Navigator with that was last seen on Hwy 70 East traveling towards Salisbury.

On June 2, Deputies were able to locate the SUV through the vehicle description.

The Iredell County Sheriff's Office identified **Nolberto Perez Coria**, 29, of Woodleaf as a suspect **wanted for murder, assault with a deadly weapon and inflicting serious injury with intent to kill**. Warrants have been drawn for Coria's arrest.

Coria is described as Hispanic male with a light complexion 6'3" tall and weighing between 180-200 pounds. This is the first homicide of the year investigated by Iredell County deputies.

PITT COUNTY -- Pitt County deputies say a handyman who is in this country illegally raped a woman he was supposed to be helping out. Deputies said that when the rape happened, the woman's toddler son was right there. Inside the Silverado Mobile Home Park Monday morning, a stove needed repair. The sheriff's office says the landlord sent handyman **Arturo Raamos-Velasco** to fix it, but what happened inside the home landed him in jail.

Sheriff Neil Elks says the handyman came to the victim's home and fixed her stove. After he was done, Elks said Velasco raped the 20-year-old woman.

The sheriff's office says the woman's 15-month-old son was there the entire time and was crying for his mother. Neighbors in the mobile home park said they know Velasco and he's not the violent type.

But the sheriff's office says Velasco was in the country illegally and is concerned a background check was never done on Velasco.

"I think it is a lack of responsibility on the landlord to send him there to do the work," Elks said.

Landlord Tony Buck said by phone that he never had a problem with Velasco before this and he never ran a background check because Velasco only did contract work. Buck also added, he did not know Velasco was here illegally and that he did not know how to do a background check.

But Sheriff Elks says the whole situation is concerning. "It's frustrating because this crime could have been prevented," Elks said.

Velasco is being charged with second-degree rape. Even though his bond was set at \$200,000, he is also being held on an immigration hold and will not be released from prison on any type of bond.

I-95 Crash Claims Life Of Raleigh Man

A Monday morning, one-car crash due to a blown tire along Interstate 95 in Dunn claimed the life of a Raleigh resident. This marks the second fatality at the same exit due to a blown tire. The victim was identified as **Julio Martinez**, 29, of Hensley Drive in Raleigh. His older brother, **Manoa Martinez**, 30, was reportedly driving the Ford Explorer when it crashed. He and his other two passengers, including Larry McDougald, 45, of Alford Drive, Raleigh, and **Francesco Machado**, 21, of Navaro Drive, Raleigh, sustained only minor injuries during the crash.

Trooper J.B. Barbour said all four occupants were wearing seat restraints and that speed was not a determining factor in the crash.

The state trooper estimated the vehicle's speed at 65 mph and said the motorist lost control of the vehicle, headed southbound along I-95, when his left, rear tire blew out. Mr. Martinez's vehicle left the roadway where he scaled a slight embankment and overturned.

The vehicle came to rest upside down and snarled in barbed wire fencing along Jerry Carr, a secondary road running parallel to the interstate.

One wooden post from the fence was lodged inside the vehicle near the front passenger area. Trooper Barbour, however, said the post did not strike the victim although emergency workers had to extricate Mr. Martinez from the SUV. None of the four occupants were ejected.

The highway patrol officer said the four men were headed to Goodyear of Fayetteville where they had been contracted to do electrical work.

2 workers identified in fatal manhole accident

DURHAM -- Authorities identified the two men who died Tuesday evening in a Durham County manhole as **Luis Castaneda Gomez**, 34, of Durham, and **Jesus Martinez Benitez**, 32, of Clayton.

The incident happened on a dirt path off Leesville Road near U.S. 70, in a rural area between Durham and Raleigh. A man called 911 about 6 p.m. when his truck broke down by the dirt path and he noticed the men in the manhole, said Major Paul Martin of Durham County Sheriff's office.

Gomez and Benitez were construction workers with **Triangle Grading and Paving**, which has a long record of safety violations. The Burlington company has been investigated 31 times for various reasons by the North Carolina Department of Labor's Occupational Safety and Health Division since 1997. The most recent violation cited by the Occupational Safety & Health Administration was in 2010. The company was fined \$57,000 for exposing workers to hazardous conditions.

Tuesday night's incident is considered a confined space accident and is being investigated by the Department of Labor, said Dolores Quesenberry, director of communications of the North Carolina Department of Labor.

Authorities are waiting for autopsy results to determine the cause of death.

"The investigation was initiated subsequent to complaints from the community and specific information provided to investigators," the release states.

Police seize 6 kilos of cocaine from illegal aliens

LUMBERTON — Lumberton police last week seized about a half-million dollars worth of cocaine that was headed for the city's streets and arrested two people from Texas on drug charges.

Lt. Jerome Morton, supervisor of the Lumberton Police Department's Drug Enforcement Division, said that **Arkadio Lopez**, 22, and 16-year-old **Joel Hernandez Jr.**, both of Houston, were arrested in the city about 6 p.m. and about 6 kilos of cocaine — just more than 13 pounds — was found in their luggage. Morton didn't want to go into specifics of the arrest, but said it was the result of an investigation that is continuing.

“Sometimes things don't pan out, but this time it all came together,” Morton said.

He said each man was **charged with trafficking cocaine by transport, trafficking cocaine by possession, and conspiracy to traffic cocaine, and each was placed in the county jail under \$500,000 secured bond.** They were scheduled to make their first court appearance on Monday.

Morton estimated the street value of the drugs to be between \$400,000 and \$500,000.

“This was drugs that were actually coming to Robeson County,” Morton said. “When we did the interview, they actually told us the drugs were coming here.

“It makes me feel wonderful knowing we took a half-million dollars worth of drugs off the street.”

Morton said after the cocaine is used for evidence in the prosecution of the two men, it will be destroyed.

Members of NC church facing deportation after stop

RALEIGH, N.C. (AP) -- More than two dozen members of a Raleigh church are facing deportation after a traffic stop in Louisiana based on what their supporters say was illegal racial profiling rather than reasonable suspicion.

Members of the Buen Pastor church and their supporters are planning a vigil in Raleigh Thursday night, on the same day that the Southern Coalition for Social Justice is planning to file a federal civil rights complaint in the case.

The group, which is representing 22 of 24 accused illegal immigrant members of the church in Charlotte Immigration Court, contends that the proceedings should be thrown out because the April 2010 traffic stop that led to them was illegally conducted from the moment federal Customs and Border Protection agents pulled three vans over late at night outside Lake Charles.

"Where they were stopped is about 500 miles from the international border," said Elizabeth Simpson, the coalition lawyer taking the church members' case. "The agents couldn't possibly have had reasonable suspicion to pull them over lawfully."

The government says **24 members of the church are illegal immigrants**. Simpson, the attorney for 22 of the 24, disputes that accusation without specifying the church members' immigration status, saying the government's claim hasn't been proved.

The two church members who aren't being represented by the group have other lawyers.

Simpson has filed a motion in immigration court to have the case thrown out. Among her arguments is that the federal agency's field manual requires three conditions for a lawful extended border search, including "reasonable certainty that the vehicle/person crossed the border," which Simpson contends is impossible given the distance of Lake Charles from the U.S. border with Mexico.

The federal government has opposed the motion, and the next court date is scheduled for Sept. 22. A U.S. Customs and Border Protection spokeswoman in New Orleans declined to comment, saying the case is still an ongoing investigation.

The church members and their supporters contend they were pulled over simply because they're Latino, and that after being detained they were subjected to ridicule by federal agents. The group also says its members were denied their legal rights to make phone calls or contact lawyers during detention.

"They just said we were suspicious, that we were suspicious people," said Jeremias Villar, one of the church members contesting the deportation order.

The incident occurred early in the morning of April 15, 2010, when three vans and several private vehicles from Buen Pastor were returning to North Carolina from a religious ceremony in Houston. Buen Pastor, an Evangelical Protestant church, regards the "Santa Cena," or holy supper, as the most important religious event of the year.

In a complaint expected to be filed with the Department of Homeland Security's Office for Civil Rights and Civil Liberties Thursday, members of the church group say they were mocked and derided by customs agents, who ridiculed everything from their religious beliefs to their distinctive dress, which includes veils for women.

"They were also subject to insults based on their ethnicity, and the congregants perceived that they had been targeted based on Latino appearance, in part because the vans were traveling at a normal speed and there was no reason for them to be pulled over," reads a draft copy of the complaint obtained by The Associated Press.

Supporters of the church members are planning to hold a candlelight vigil on their behalf Thursday night at Pullen Memorial Baptist Church in Raleigh, a congregation that's long been active in civil rights causes.

"We are a bit worried, like we've lost some hope, but we're with the church and praying together," Villar said.

Sheriff's office busts counterfeit document lab

The Alamance County Sheriff's Office and N.C. Alcohol Law Enforcement busted a counterfeit document operation in Burlington on Thursday after a two month investigation.

The two-month investigation of alleged **trafficking in stolen identities and manufacturing fraudulent identification** began with tips from the community, and included undercover operations, according to a news release.

Authorities made one arrest and have drawn warrants against second person who is not in custody.

A search warrant was served at 1160 Wyatt Road, Lot E2, Burlington, where officers seized fraudulent resident alien cards and counterfeit Social Security cards, as well as computer equipment, printers and other items used in the manufacture of fraudulent identifications.

"This is not the first document lab we've hit," said sheriff spokesman Randy Jones, citing another lab in Burlington the sheriff's office exposed last year. However, Jones said, Thursday's bust was probably the only one within the last year to result in an arrest.

Jones said tips often lead to evidence suggesting fraudulent operations, but not enough to make an arrest.

"You don't always get everything," said Jones. "It's always hit or miss on these types of things."

Delia Sosa Pacheco, 42, of Wyatt Road, **was charged with possession of fraudulent identification and manufacturing of fraudulent identification**. The release states Pacheco was placed in the Alamance County jail under a \$5,000 bond and was processed through the federal 287 (g) post-arrest screening program.

Following her arrest, **a federal immigration detainer was filed against Pacheco by Immigration and Customs Enforcement. Investigators have also obtained warrants for the arrest of Alfredo Pacheco-Martinez, 42, also of Wyatt Road, on charges of trafficking stolen identities, possession of fraudulent identifications, and manufacturing fraudulent identifications.**

Jones said, "We consider any fraudulent document location (bust) to be significant," since there's no way of knowing how many counterfeit identifications have been created and circulated. The fraudulent activities these counterfeit documents lead to is one of the sheriff's office's primary concerns, Jones said.

If enough forms of counterfeit identification are made – and made well – a person can do anything in society, from purchasing airline tickets to obtaining a gun permit, said Jones.

"It allows all types of problems and activities to take place," he said.

Pacheco-Martinez is being sought by authorities. More arrests are expected.

Illegal Alien Murder Suspect Arrested

SALISBURY — **Jose Daniel Torres Castro**, wanted for the June 9 murder of Guillermo Montes-Gonzalez, was arrested by the Kerens, Texas, Police Department during a traffic stop earlier this week, the Rowan County Sheriff's Office reported this afternoon.

Kerens is about 70 miles southeast of Dallas.

Authorities said the N.C. SBI, Immigration Customs Enforcement, N.C. Highway Patrol and Davie County Sheriff's Office assisted in the investigation and arrest, and that when arrested, **Castro gave a fake name of Jorge Salgado Ortiz.**

Castro, 23, of 2110 Harrison Road, is the main suspect in the murder, and is in the Navarro County Jail in Texas being held without bond until extradition is arranged, authorities said.

No further details of the investigation or arrest were available.

Castro's mother, Maria Castro, 38, was charged June 11 with accessory to first-degree murder after the fact for helping her son try to move and hide the blue van that belonged to Montes-Gonzalez, authorities said, and for giving false information to investigators. The van ended up being found in the Castro's driveway. Maria Castro is under a \$125,000 bond in the Rowan County jail.

Montes-Gonzalez, 29, of 165 S. Oakhurst Lane, was found shot to death in the early hours of June 9 in a cul-de-sac at the end of Barley Run in western Rowan County. Montes-Gonzalez left behind his wife, Magali Solano Garcia, and his three children, ages 3, 5 and 11.

Magali Garcia told a Post reporter there was no "bad blood" between Castro and Montes-Gonzalez, and wants to know why her husband was killed.

Food benefits for children are routed through illegal immigrants

GRAHAM — Nearly 900 illegal immigrants who are heads of household in Alamance County receive food stamp electronic benefit transfer cards monthly, based on federal requirements to provide benefits to others living in their household who qualify.

Alamance County Department of Social Services Director Susan Osborne said on Thursday during a county DSS board meeting that illegal immigrants who receive the cards aren't supposed to use the cards for themselves.

“We don't issue food stamps to illegal aliens,” Osborne said.

Sometime last month, Alamance County Commissioner Tim Sutton asked Alamance County DSS officials to provide him with information about how many illegal immigrants were issued the EBT cards for food stamps to use for their children. He also asked that the Times-News ask the county DSS more about the program.

According to Osborne, EBT food stamp cards are issued to illegal immigrants who have children who are U.S. citizens who qualify for the benefits. The county can't issue the cards directly to those residents under 18, so they are issued to a head of household instead.

Currently, 878 non-qualified alien Hispanic heads of household receive the EBT food stamp cards in Alamance County. According to county DSS officials, there are 10,802 total households countywide receiving food and nutritional services through food stamps.

The county DSS hadn't previously recorded how many illegal immigrant heads of households had received the cards until this year. Linda Allison, DSS assistant director, said the department will continue to track these numbers.

Overall, the number of households in the county that receive food stamp benefits has increased for at least the past five years. There were 9,244 households receiving food and nutritional services in April 2010, 5,628 households in April 2008 and 4,257 households in April 2006.

Currently, there are about 25,000 people in the 10,802 total households in Alamance County receiving food and nutritional services.

Osborne said \$310,278 in food and nutritional benefits are provided monthly to the 878 households in Alamance County that are headed by an illegal immigrant.

The EBT food stamp card allotments made available to a household per month with no income range from \$200 for one person to \$1,202 for eight people living in a household, according to the county DSS.

Allison said on Wednesday that county DSS officials can't say for sure that all illegal immigrants in the 878 households are playing by the rules.

Man charged with statutory rape

NC Sex offender charged with assault on girl

LAKESWOOD — A 30-year-old man previously convicted of a child sex crime in North Carolina is now accused of sexually assaulting a township girl under 13 over a two-year period.

Jacias Nicholas Lopez, who was using the name Carlos Lopez, was arrested and charged with aggravated sexual assault, sex assault and endangering the welfare of a child, according to Deputy Chief Michael Mohel of the Ocean County Prosecutor's Office.

Lopez was convicted on Mar. 31, 2004, of taking indecent liberties with a child in Forsyth County, N.C., according to the North Carolina Sex Offenders Registry.

Detective Melissa Matthews, of the Ocean County Prosecutor's Office Special Victims Unit, and Detective Jason Pederson, of the Lakewood Police Department, arrested Lopez with the assistance of the State Police and U.S. Marshal's Service on Thursday.

Lopez is being held in the Ocean County Jail in Toms River on \$250,000 bail with no option to post 10 percent. He is also ordered to have no contact with his victim and to surrender his passport to authorities, plus he has a detainer on his release by U.S. Immigration and Customs Enforcement.

Statewide burglary ring broken up, NC connection

State authorities busted up an eight-person Miami-based burglary ring that netted more than \$6 million in stolen jewelry from pawn shops and jewelry stores in Florida, North Carolina, Tennessee, Virginia, West Virginia and Connecticut. The arrests mark the culmination of a nearly two-year multi-agency investigation into an organized burglary ring based out of Miami-Dade County. The ring operated with multiple crews of burglars who would burglarize jewelry stores and pawn shops by cutting holes in the roof, disabling alarms and surveillance systems and using torches to access safes.

The Florida Department of Law Enforcement's Jacksonville Regional Operations Center and Attorney General Pam Bondi's Office of Statewide Prosecution, with the cooperation of 19 police and sheriff's departments in the six states hit, aided in the investigation.

“The large-scale cooperation among the various law enforcement agencies was a vast undertaking that will result in justice for the victims of these burglaries,” Bondi said.

The following individuals were arrested between May 19 and May 24 and charged with racketeering and conspiracy to commit racketeering: **Jose Betancourt**, 43, of Miami; **Yenier Cardentey**, 31, of Miami Gardens; **Juan Collado-Miranda**, 44, of Coral Gables; **Juan Manresa-Leyva**, 41, of Hollywood; **Abelardo Pena-Cardentey**, 33, of Fort Lauderdale; **Maykel Roque**, 27, of Miami Gardens; **Tony Sanchez**, 26, of Miami; and **Yaubri Suarez**, 30, of Hialeah.

Authorities have active warrants for **Oswaldo Cruz**, 40, of Hialeah Gardens, for racketeering and conspiracy to commit racketeering. Individuals with information about his location should contact their local authorities.

The case remains active and ongoing. The case will be prosecuted by Bondi’s office.

NC murder suspect arrested in Texas

Passenger allegedly connected with drug cartel

Last week, Kerens Police Officer Benny Monteagudo stopped a speeding car containing six people, two who said they were from North Carolina, two who said they were from Atlanta, Ga., and two from Nashville, Tenn.

The car, however, was registered in Mississippi. Suspicious, Monteagudo continued questioning them and finally, the agency called in Agent J.D. Rojas with the Immigration and Customs Enforcement (ICE) from the Dallas field office.

The ICE agent also interviewed the driver and passengers and he was able to confirm that **one of the people was connected to a drug cartel in Mexico**. Because the man was unable to offer any other identifying

information, he was arrested on charges of failure to identify, and the \$2,500 he was carrying was seized as possible drug money.

In addition, the Navarro College Police Department was called to bring out its K-9 unit. The dog alerted on several spots around the car, and a complete search was conducted. No narcotics were found. The other people in the car were allowed to go free.

Arrested at the scene was a man identified as **Jorge Sagado Ortiz of Atlanta, Ga. After he was booked, it was discovered that the Rowan County Sheriff's Department in Salisbury, N.C., has an active murder warrant out for his arrest.** He is now awaiting extradition to North Carolina.

Mexico's Most Powerful Drug Trafficking Organization In Charlotte

CHARLOTTE, N.C. -- The Mexican drug cartel is one of the most dangerous criminal organizations in the world. Its structure rivals a fortune 500 company.

Charlotte-Mecklenburg Police says Charlotte is a distribution hub for one cartel known for controlling a drug rising in use. "Black tar heroin is controlled by the Mexican drug cartel," said Major Glen Neimeyer from the CMPD Special Investigations Bureau. "The **Sinaloa Cartel** is who's responsible for most of the black tar heroin exported out of Mexico."

Charlotte is one of the top five U.S. cities in sales and distribution for this drug. "I've had friends who've been personally affected by this," said Charlotte Mayor Anthony Foxx. "One of my former colleagues lost a son to black tar heroin."

That's one reason why Mayor Foxx wants to raise awareness, to stop people from buying the drug. But CMPD is also on alert because of what follows drugs associated with the cartel. "You know over the drug trade, and over the cartels, there's people dying everyday [in Mexico]," said Neimeyer.

Seven criminal organizations make up the Mexican drug cartel with footprints throughout that country. Starting on the west coast, there's Tijuana, Pacifico Sur, Juarez, Los Zetas, the Gulf Cartel, La Familia, and Sinaloa, which is one of the biggest and most powerful.

It used to be that the cartels would distribute their drugs to border towns, like El Paso or McAllen, Texas. Drug dealers based in the U.S. would pick up the drugs, and transport them to distribution centers like Atlanta. From there, the drugs would travel up the eastern seaboard to cities like Charlotte, Washington, D.C., Philadelphia and then New York.

Now, it appears the Sinaloa cartel is distributing black tar heroin directly to Charlotte, skipping the middle man. **That criminal organization is run by Joaquin "El Chapo" Guzman. He's known as the godfather of the drug world.**

According to the U.S. Drug Enforcement Administration, Guzman is the most wanted criminal in the world. He's introduced drugs like marijuana, heroin, meth and cocaine to Europe and Asia. Guzman may have his eye on the Queen City.

Mayor Foxx says CMPD informs him the city's location and transportation infrastructure is one reason. But he also says it's about the money and "the affluence in this community, coupled with ignorance about the existence of this particular drug."

Experts on the cartel say if they're distributing directly to Charlotte, other drugs are soon to follow. And if one cartel benefits from selling here, other cartels will try to set up as well. And CMPD says that's the game changer because of the violence that comes with turf wars.

Man held on \$1 million bond after drug arrest
